Growing in Insight-ability of Mobility GIM

Project financed by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union

GIM is a capacity-building project involving 4 partners from Romania, Italy, Argentina and Peru. The specific aim of the project is to build competences of youth workers in order to empower inclusion, active participation and entrepreneurial skills of fewer opportunities youth, as well as youth who have minor disabilities, from South America and Europe, excluded on behalf of their impairment, social status, financial status or education.

The objectives of GIM are (1) fostering empowerment - active participation and sense of entrepreneurship of fewer opportunities youth and (2) promoting social inclusion of this target group aged 18 to 25 years old in their countries through developing comprehensive NFE educational methods and techniques by deploying a complementary set of knowledge, experience and specialised competences embedded in the different partner organisations and regional approaches. In the same time we are bridging involvement of successful entrepreneurs and youth/social workers and the target youth for inspiring entrepreneurial dialogue and action taking amongst NGOs and their beneficiaries.

The second trans-national meeting, the mid-term evaluation, takes place in Sassari, Italy, between February 7-10, 2020. The meeting brings together responsible of all partners (project managers / coordinators) that will discuss topics regarding intermediate results, evaluation of the previous activities, the seminar in Peru (May-June 2019) and the training course in Sardinia (September 2019), plan the next youth exchange in Buenos Aires, Argentina and the job shadowings in Romania and Peru. During the meeting, the partners will also discuss details of the dissemination plan and the web platform of the project.

The official opening of the meeting will be on Friday, February 7, 2020, 10:00 AM, at the Hotel Grazia Deledda, Sassari, Italy.
